#### MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES AND RATES

#### FULL MEMBERSHIP - \$2,500.00

Open to all professional members of the Library and Information Science fields in Jamaica. Full members are entitled to hold office in the Association and enjoy all benefits negotiated by the Association on their behalf.

#### ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP - \$1,500.00

Open to all persons engaged in, or interested in Library and Information work, but who are not professionally qualified in these pursuits. Organizations interested in the Library and Information field, but not directly engaged in it, may also be admitted to Associate membership. Associate members shall have the same rights and privileges as full members except that they may not be elected to any office of the Association.

#### RETIRED MEMBERSHIP - \$ 1,000.00

Open to all members of the Library and Information profession who are within five years of retirement.

## STUDENT MEMBERSHIP - \$ 600.00

Open to all persons who are in full or part-time education on an accredited course in an institution of Library an Information Studies. Such members shall have the same rights as Associate members.

CORPORATE/INSTITUTIONAL/SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP - \$5,000.00/School: \$2,500.00 Open to organizations working in the Library and Information Field. Institutional members shall be entitled to delegate a member of its governing body to represent it. Such delegate may attend meetings of the Association and on behalf of the organization represented, shall enjoy all the rights and privileges of full membership.

#### CORRESPONDING MEMBERSHIP - US \$50.00

Open to institutions and persons resident overseas. Corresponding members shall be entitled to receive the publications usually distributed to members, but may not be elected to any office of the Association or vote at a General Meeting.

#### HONORARY MEMBERSHIP - None

Persons who have shown a keen interest in Library and Information development, and have otherwise given outstanding service to the Association maybe admitted to Honorary membership shall be submitted with supporting evidence of the Executive Committee, the Executive Committee shall consider such nominations and endorse nominations shall be presented at an Annual General Meeting. Honorary members shall have the same rights and privileges as an Associate member.

### SUSTAINING MEMBERSHIP

Shall be conferred on an institution or individual interested in Library and Information Services who makes a substantial contribution to the association over a period of no less than three consecutive years. A sustaining member shall have the same rights and privileges as an Associate member.
